

# Coppell High School Sports Medicine

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Attention Parents:

The Coppell Independent School District requires all athletes to obtain an annual Athletic Physical, Medical History, Illegal Steroid Use Agreement Form, and Emergency Medical Form (Notarized) in order to participate in athletics.

**All forms are due to your child's coach the first day of practice.**

The Coppell High School Sports Medicine program will be scheduling athletic physicals for **\$20.00** for the 2010-11 school year. All appointments must be scheduled through the High School Athletic Training Office @ **214-496-7066**.

1. Call the CHS Athletic Training Office beginning **March 29<sup>nd</sup>** for your appointment(s) at **214-496-7066**. (First come first serve basis to the **first 400**)
2. **Print** the following forms from your school website: (Under 'Student Activities', click on 'Forms')
  - a. Preparticipation Physical Form
  - b. Emergency Information
  - c. UIL & CISD Athletic Policies
  - d. UIL Acknowledgement of Rules form
  - e. UIL Steroid Agreement
3. Complete forms A & B prior to the day of physicals
4. Bring forms A & B the date of your scheduled physical (B can be notarized on site)
5. Keep ALL forms (A-E) & give them to YOUR child's coach by the first day of practice next school year. *To Prevent Loss of Forms, **Do Not** Send Forms to the Athletic Training Office or Athletic Office*

If you are unable to participate in this event it will be your responsibility to schedule a physical exam with your physician prior to your first day of practice next school year.
